# Secretary

- Serves as the record keeper and historian of the Student Branch. He/she is responsible for maintaining all records.
- Maintain the membership roster and committee assignments on the Branch website.
- Conducts bi-weekly meetings and keep track of important resolutions passed.
- Post the minutes of the meeting and maintain documentation for the same. Post a calendar of events.
- Important communication link between the chair and the advisors. Be responsible for all correspondence.
- Arrange for an orderly transfer of all records to the incoming board members
- Ensure that the Branch Constitution and Bylaws are adhered to.



# Graduate Activities Chair

- These positions are one of the most important because they need to work with almost all other chairs to plan and execute events.
- These may include Tech Talks, info sessions, poster presenting events, workshops.
- They need to understand what part of their major is currently in demand so that IEEE as an organization can conduct events that are relevant to both their study and also aims at an exposure to the industries.
- They can talk to Professors and other important people whose talks would benefit any student specializing in that field.
- Be the voice of the graduate student community through newsletters or any specific media.

# Technical Chair

- This position is for conducting workshops and other related engineering work which would concern both the undergrad and grad curriculum.
- They can either choose doing the workshops by themselves if they are good enough in the field they would be conducting the workshop in or they can also invite in companies or groups who are ready to do workshops for the students at ASU.
- They can collaborate with the Grad and Undergrad chairs in order to be more precise and get better idea to what would be the best topics to conduct the events on.
- Needed person with sound technical skills, open-minded to answering questions and strong communication skills.

# Outreach Chair

- Communicate with the executive committee members of Phoenix Section and Region 6, document the same at a report and submit to the faculty advisor.
- Attend section conference meetings and conferences.
- Collaborate with other student organizations for joint events.
- Communicates with student branches from various sections and regions across the globe.
- Spread awareness regarding initiatives taken by IEEE, activities, conferences, hackathons, etc.

# Engineering Progress Chair

- Be in constant contact with Fulton schools of Engineering advisors and good knowledge of all programs offered at the university.
- Invite faculty and university affiliated staff for guest lectures and professional development workshops.
- Awareness regarding campus activities and competitions.
- Help fellow students in obtaining course materials, solve queries regarding course selection and resolving conflicts related to academics.
- Organize field trips or special events beyond regular program efforts.
- Assist the Branch Chair in following up on assigned committee responsibilities.

# Membership Chair

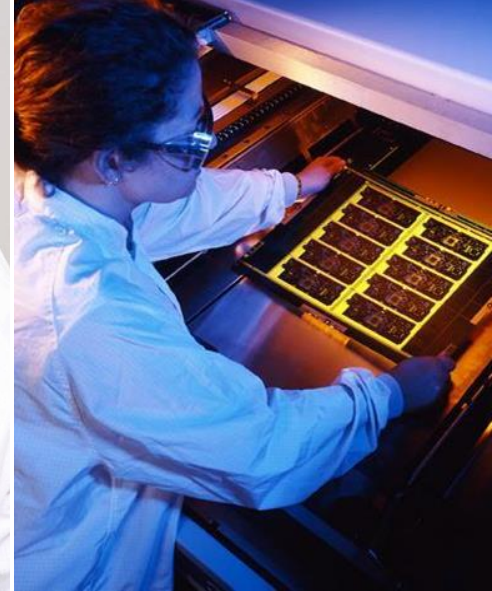
- Conduct membership drives every semester.

- The board meeting will be organized through Zoom sessions on Saturday; link and timeslots of which will be sent out to those interested based on the Google Form responses. Please come prepared with an **elevator pitch of about 2-3 minutes** and not more than that, which should state a little bit of your background, why do you want to join IEEE, why do you consider yourself a good fit for the position you are applying for and what more do you have to offer our student branch.
